EXECUTIVE ORDER NUMBER 9

Creation of a Committee to Study the Physical and Educational Needs at the Delaware State College and to Recommend a Policy Regarding its Future

By Order of the Governor of the State of Delaware and in accordance with the authority vested in Him by the Constitution and Laws of this State:

1. There is hereby established a Committee to Study the Physical and Educational Needs at the Delaware State College and to Recommend a Policy Regarding its Future, to be composed of the Chairman, Houston Wilson, Esquire, Georgetown, Delaware, a Secretary and an unlimited number of general committeemen as is required to efficiently carry out the duties of the Committee, and who are appointed by the Governor.

2. Such Committee shall study the physical and educational conditions at the Delaware State College with a view to recommending to the Governor a policy to help determine the future course the College will take. The Committee will report to the Governor as promptly as possible the results of its deliberations.

3. Such Committee shall meet upon call of the Chairman.

4. The expiration date of the Committee will be on January 1, 1952.

5. This Order shall take effect on January 22, 1951.
