EXECUTIVE ORDER
NUMBER THREE

TO: HEADS OF ALL STATE DEPARTMENTS AND AGENCIES
RE: CONTINUATION AND TRANSFER OF THE OFFICE OF FEDERAL-STATE
HIGHWAY SAFETY COORDINATOR

WHEREAS, it is desirable to continue the functions of the
Office of Federal-State Highway Safety Coordinator and to continue
and, where possible, expand the program of improved highway safety;
and

WHEREAS, the previous administration continued by Executive
Order 15 the Office of the Federal-State Highway Safety Coordinator;
and

WHEREAS, the Governor of the State of Delaware, being
vitally interested and personally concerned with all aspects of the
State's safety program, will continue as the State official ultimately
responsible to the Federal Government for the conduct of such
program and has seen fit to place the direction and administration
of the Office of the Federal-State Highway Safety Programs directly
under the Office of the Governor;

NOW, THEREFORE, I, SHERMAN W. TRIBBITT, by virtue of the
authority vested in me as Governor of the State of Delaware do
hereby amend Executive Order No. 42, dated September 24, 1970, as
follows:

- 1. The Office of the Federal-State Highway Safety
Coordinator is to be placed under the Office of the Governor.
2. The Coordinator of the Federal-State Highway Safety
Office will also serve at the pleasure of the Governor. His
representative for Highway Safety will be responsible to the
Governor for the conduct of the Highway Safety Program for the
State of Delaware.
