Committee minutes often contain copies of report for review by, or requested by the committee.

Task forces were created for specific pieces of legislation, 2003-2008. Topics include charter school standards, commuter rail, early childhood education, parental accountability, Philadelphia airport, poultry issues, Route One traffic mitigation, truancy, adult autism, personnel practices (most confidential), physical education, alcohol awareness, and student assessment.
