 270 Entries show date; case number; names of plaintiff, defendant, constable, and surety; amount of judgment; and court cost. Of special interest are the volumes dated 1798-1802 and 1823-1825 which include bastardy cases; the 1821-1831 volume which contains day book entries for 1833 and 1834 for the People's Line Stagecoach Company showing departure, departure dates, names of passengers, departure and destination points, and fares; and the 1865-1892 volume which also has personal credit and debit entries for Robert J. Hill of Milford for the year 1865.

Among the justices whose records appear in the dockets are William Berry (1793-1795), Nathaniel Smithers (1798-1802), John Ralston (1799-1802), James Schnee (1818-1819), Alexander McClyment (1821-1831), Jacob Furbee (1823-1826), John Robertson (1825-1828), Jacob Biddle (1828-1829), William Ringgold (1835-1836), Thomas Stevenson of Dover (1835-1845), Robert J. Hill of Milford (1865-1892), B. T. Fleming of Farmington (1867-1913), Joseph Ward of Farmington (1871-1908), Jonathan Pratt (1874-1876), George B. Dickson (1876-1880), John S. Jester (1883-1884), W. B. Tharp, Philip J. Smart, James R. Short, R. J. Besnick, William D. Fowler, and Harry B. Thaw of Smyrna (1932-1942). William Berry also has a fee book noted elsewhere.
