270 Applications show number and date; name, address, age, race, and occupation of bride and groom; name and address of parents of bride and groom; whether previously married, place and date of previous marriage, and if marriage was terminated by death or divorce; if bride or groom are or have been patients of institutions or are currently on probation or parole; signatures of bride and groom; date and time of application, signature of justice of the peace; and date and time of marriage, and name of individual performing the ceremony. Consent forms are attached to applications if either the bride or groom was a minor. Volume 1921-1924 belonged to Francis E. Postles and John D. Griffin and Volumes 1921-1927 belonged to Wilson D. Burton.
Note: Date of marriage was not always recorded. See Marriage Returns for date of marriage.
