The earliest criminal cases in the Superior Court that begin June, 1951, are in the last General Sessions Court Docket (1947-1952). Editor's note: it is not uncommon that this volume is labeled General Sessions and dated after Court "officially" ended. Volume probably existed before change and would have been used rather than wasted. Court knew what was going on and saw no need to fix the label.
