261 Primarily resolutions from the State Highway Department declaring the abandonment of a road (now called road closures) or petitions to the court requesting that a road(s) be abandoned or built.
270 The State Highway Department resolutions describe what portion of the road is to be vacated, reasons for the abandonment, conditions or agreements with adjoining land owners, date of resolution, signatures of the Department of Secretary and Division Director, and a plot of the road affected. Petitions show the names and signatures of petitioners, reason for the petition, and description of road location. Related documents include notices to the State Highway Department of the petition, court orders for the appointment of commissioners, commissioners' return, bill of costs, and final court order. For earlier records, 1754-1951, see 4805-000-017 and 4840-000-004.
NB: Note in the last volume of the road books (4840-000-004) "Effective October 1, 1977 Road Resolutions and Vacation to be recorded in the [Superior Court] Miscellaneous Books".
