261 The Potter estate consists of a number of farms situated near Milford. It is administered by a trustee appointed by the Court of Chancery to whom he is responsible. The proceeds are given for charitable purposes according to the provisions of the will.  
270 Contains 2 volumes of estate records including a copy of the will of Benjamin Potter showing surveys and description of lands owned by the estate; itemized statements of receipts and expenditures made to the court by the trustees.  
One volume of leases contains copies of leases given by the trustee of the Potter Charity Estate showing date, names of lessee and lessor, term of lease, rental and signatures of lessee and lessor. One volume index to chancery proceedings, leases, etc., connected with the Potter Estate showing names of lessee, lessor, person having business with the estate, and reference to volume and page numbers.
