270 Volume entries show name of testator, name of trustee, post office address, date of appointment, date account passed, and reference to title and page number of volume in which the account is recorded. The manuscript records (ca. 1925-1976) consist of copies of wills which establish a trust and may also have a Register's Certificate attached. The certificate is a statement by the Register of Wills which shows the date, who letters testamentary or letters of administration were granted to, name of deceased, place of abode, trustee named in the will, date and signature of Register of Wills, date filed in Chancery, volume and page recorded in, and the signature of the Register in Chancery.
