 problems that had surfaced within the agency, and specific areas of
 concern for the entire State. Of special interest is the 1945 report
 from the president of the Council of Executives on the activities of the
 Council from its inception until its merger with the Council of
 Presidents of State Agencies. Also of interest are the 1942 report to
 the Governor on the status of State agencies including specific Council
 recommendations (observations on health, education and welfare
 institutions); the 1947 reports from the revenue, delinquency, relief,
 and education committees; the 1950 reports of the standing committees,
 as well as reports from the cultural resources, public building, and
 pension and revisions committees. Also included are the 1951 proposed
 program for addressing health care needs during times of financial
 crises within the State; the 1953 social security and pension survey; a
 1962 committee report on uniform personnel policies; the 1963 draft of a
 bill establishing a State personnel department; and other undated
 reports and proposals.

 The 1942 "Report to His Excellency, W. W. Bacon..." on the projected
 State activities includes the proposal for retirement plans for State
 employees, establishment of minimum requirements for State positions,
 maximum and minimum salary scales, restrictions and new methods of
 expenditures, and unification of laws.
