 261 Correspondence and reports that were collected during Jack Markell's two terms as the governor of Delaware.

270 Documents and materials found in Governor Markell's papers were personal correspondence, business correspondence, reports, invitations, and records. The personal correspondence consists of greeting and holiday cards from families, other state governors, organizations, and individual acquaintances. Also found in the personal correspondence is a certificate from the Commonwealth of Kentucky appointing Governor Markell as a Kentucky Colonel. The business correspondence contains communication between various Delaware agencies and organizations, federal government agencies, and private national and international organizations. Among the business correspondence is a proclamation from the President of the United States, which explains the establishment of the First State National Monument. Governor Markell also received a document from the Confucius Institute Headquarters which discusses the collaboration of Chinese culture in Delaware schools. Newspaper clippings of Governor Markell making state addresses and posing with various organization officials can also be found. Other details discussed in the business correspondence are budget and legislative concerns, and issues in the Delaware community.

The reports found in Governor Markell's papers are annual reports, agency plans and proposals, and legacy memos from state and private agencies and organizations. Among the reports are not only records from Governor Markell's terms, but there are also reports from Governor Carper and Governor Minner's terms. These reports consist of the past and present statuses of Delaware agencies, along with proposals and plans for the future. Invitations from different organizations are also found among the files. Some of the invitations are for galas, theater performances, and black tie events. There are also inaugural invitations for President Barack Obama, Governor Minner, Governor Carper, and Governor Markell himself.

The remainder of the governor's papers are four cubic feet boxes of privileged records and will be confidential for the next 20 years. These records consist of overviews, legacy reports, and drafts from state and private agencies that were given to the governor and labeled privileged and/or confidential.
