Minutes of the Committee on Conservation of Cultural Resources are here with reports and pamphlets on how other states kept their records: North Carolina, South Carolina, Virginia, Massachusetts, and Illinois as well as newsletters of various military units from Delaware and other states. Ration coupons are filed with Chapter 22 records.
