270 This record is primarily correspondence between State Archivist Leon de Valinger and those who knew the soldier, including family members, staff of organizations, and religious leaders. The first folder contains correspondence without any soldier's names mentioned and those with requests on more than one soldier. The last four folders are alphabetically by the name of the soldier. The last two folders in the box refer to correspondence between de Valinger and The World War II Veteran's Compensation Bureau of Harrisburg, Pennsylvania, to see if the soldiers had been counted by The State of Pennsylvania. These two folders are arranged by soldiers names. Some of these soldiers are also listed in 1325-003-053.
