261 The State Board of Agriculture was responsible for the protection and
promotion of agriculture in the state and its Bureau of Markets was most
heavily involved with promoting the overall economic development of the
state. The Board's staff photographer, Roydon L. Hammond, traveled
throughout the state and photographed local scenes, buildings, and
agricultural subjects many of which were later used in promotional
publications.
270 The majority of the photographs are agriculture-related, although many
other subjects are documented in this series. Topics include ethnic
groups, bridges, businesses and industries, churches, scenes for many
cities and towns, houses, portraits, public buildings, recreation and
sports events, roads, and schools. The Dover area is especially well
represented. Agriculture related subjects include farm animals,
buildings, various crops, fairs and expositions, harvesting activities,
horticulture, laborers, and marketing. Many of these photographs
pertain to the poultry and fruit industries. The first 494 prints were
placed in albums. We do not have original prints for all negatives so
the only way to view the entire collection is to view the microfilm.
