 270 Applications give the farm owner; address; number of acres; main crops; date of original purchase by ancestors; legal descriptions of land; list of all family owners; information on the first owner; building, crops or livestock raised; accompanying documents may include originals or copies of photographs of the farm, copies of documents relating to the land, histories of property and National Register of Historic Places Registration forms. One application includes a master's thesis on the Richard's House, Locust Grove Farm, Greenwood. Files contain correspondence to and from the council president or secretary, news clippings or copies of news articles, and copies of legislation.
