261 Files of claims originally rejected for failure to apply by January 1, 1951, but were reactivated for payment when the application period was extended. Files include application for bonus, copy of separation/discharge paper (DD 214), and occasionally other supporting documents.

270 Files include original applications for bonus claim and copy of separation/discharge papers. Both forms show name, address and physical description of veteran, branch of service, claim number, dates of service, place of entry and discharge, date of document, and signature of veteran. Separation/discharge shows rank, military occupation, battles and campaigns participated in, decorations and citations received, and dates of service outside the United States. Reason for rejection usually noted on folder or application form. Other supporting documents occasionally included are correspondence to and from the Commission or applicant, and copies of awards and citations. In 1957 an Act of the General Assembly (SB#528) extended the claim period one additional year.
