270 Death Records may show date of death, name and residence of deceased, sex, race, age, occupation, disease or complications, name of father and mother and their birth places, date of death certificate, signature of undertaker, and place of interment.  
As you will have noted from the agency history, the keeping of the above records for the early years was extremely informal at best. Therefore, the contents of the records can differ greatly. As would be naturally expected the earlier records generally tend to contain less information than the more recent records. Recorder of Deed's Office is noted on most returns.
