270 These forms may show the birth registration number, correction number, relationship of the person making the statement to the child, sex of the child, birth date, name of father, mother's maiden name, name of child, date of statement, signature of the person making the statement, and signature and seal of a notary public. Some statements are accompanied by copies of baptismal or other church records, school records, marriage certificates, and change of name court records. The correction books include births from 1851 to 1913. The loosefiles include births from 1896 to 1993. There are nine folders containing records for 1896-1913.
