261 State law requires hospitals and other medical facilities to provide information on patients with cancer or specified benign tumors to the Division. The purpose is to create a "central data bank of accurate, precise and current information" on these diseases.
270 The abstracts are computer printouts which show the case number, patient information, tumor information, treatment, and follow up information. Patient information includes name, social security number, address, phone number, race, sex, religion, date and place of birth, occupation, company, marital status, name of spouse, and name, address, and phone number of children. Tumor information includes date of diagnosis, site of tumor, description of tumor, name of hospital, x-ray diagnostic, lab tests, and clinical findings. Treatment shows the types of surgery, radiation, or chemotherapy done. Follow up information may include date of last follow up or death, status of patient and tumor, follow up method, date and type of first recurrence, place and cause of death, follow up physicians, and comments. The registry was first called the tumor registry.
