Complaints give the name of the Attorney General, nature of the complaint, and name of complainant. Reverse shows name of Attorney General and synopsis of complaint. The letter gives a statement of the actions of a sheriff or constable and the reason for the action (jailing of an escaped, black, female slave). Summonses show name of person summoned, place and date to appear, name of Attorney General, date recorded, and signatures of the Attorney General and Deputy Attorney General.
