261 Files maintained on requests for nonutility wells within a service territory served by a water utility. The Department can not withhold a permit for a potable water well within the service territory served by a water utility under a certificate of public convenience and necessity, or require an applicant for a potable water well permit in an area served by a water utility to utilize the services of the utility unless certain conditions existed.

270 Most of the files contain correspondence accompanying an application submission for a certificate of public convenience and necessity. Many records are copies of checks sent in for payment of fees, copies of deposit slips, and proof of newspaper advertizing. Only a few applications are contained in the files. Applications give the name and address of the water utility, name of the utility representative, phone number, and the basis for the application. One folder is weekly reports for the Financial Assistance Branch, 1999.
