 The survey plot shows the locations of the stone boundary markers,
 roads, railroad lines, houses of named adjoining landowners and tenants,
 other buildings, ditches, and the villages of Staytonsville, Adamsville,
 and Farmington. The original surveyor died and was replaced by John C.
 Hopkins and Alfred Short. Other roll was a copy filed with the Kent
 County Recorder of Deeds.
