military activities from King George's War (c1744) through the War of
1812 to about 1827. The collection was created for publication.
270 Types of records found here include muster in and out rolls; payroll
records; correspondence concerning funding, clothing, troop recruitment,
military action, petitions from soldiers concerning back pay, pensions,
etc.; court proceeding in treason cases; and materials reflecting the
effects of war on the local population. A sixth "volume" of material
that was never published is included here. The type of records in the
sixth volume is no different from those appearing in the first five
volumes. For further information on the "6th" volume see Hancock,
Harold B., ed., "Revolutionary War Period Material in the Hall of
Records, 1775-1787: Four Little Known Sources," Delaware History.
17:54-85. Also included is an unpublished volume of "Pension Rolls and
Correspondence," 1790-1846. This volume includes an index to names of
pensioners, including death dates when known, and an index to
correspondence between pensioners and government officials. See RG
1800.66 for additional Revolutionary War records.
