261 Citizens were required to take an oath of allegiance or declaration of fidelity to the new nation or to the Delaware State and abandon all loyalty to the King of Great Britain. Those who refused were ineligible to hold office, vote or serve on juries.  
270 Oaths of Allegiance show the oath taken, name of person sworn before, date of swearing, and signature of person taking the oath. The records include the oaths of allegiance of New Jersey residents administered by Caesar Rodney while stationed at Trenton and a typed transcript of the 1778 legislation requiring the oaths.
