 261 Typed transcripts of muster rolls from the American Revolution through World War II.
 270 The muster rolls of the Revolutionary War soldiers are divided by regiments and listed alphabetically with rank noted. Sometimes noted on the rolls is where the soldier was killed, buried, missing in action or deserted. The muster list for the Civil War is divided by companies and listed alphabetically with the rank. Sometimes noted is the burial place, variations on the spelling of names, and if killed or wounded. The Grand Army of the Republic (GAR) post records of servicemen from 1825 - 1900 include place of birth, age, trade, date of enlistment and discharge, address, if wounded & where, and sometimes burial. The Delaware posts include DuPont, Capt. T.M. Reynolds, Capt. Hydrick, and Phil Sheridan. Also included is a muster roll of the Provisional Brigade of United States Marines in Panama, 1904. This list shows the names of staff, rank, number of soldiers in each regiment and battalion, and their duties. The muster roll of the 28th United States Infantry at Ft. Snelling, Minnesota, 1905, lists the names and rank. The muster list from the Spanish-American War, including the 59th Pioneer Infantry from January 1918 to July 1919, shows the names, rank, and cemetery. A working muster list of soldiers from 1898, in alphabetical order, includes the addresses and a list of unidentified letters after the soldier's names. Finally, there is a roster of the Delmarva Camp #14, Department of Maryland, 1937.
