27X The DARBC maintained general office files which contained originals and
copies of inquiries received and responses made by the staff as well as
general subject files Newsletters, promotional pamphlets, etc, of
similar organizations in other states are included here. Some of the
topics included in the files are American Freedom Train, Arts Committee,
Delaware Day 1975, Caesar Rodney's Ride, Separation Day, etc.
A sister organization, the Bicentennial Council of the 13 Original
States, operated in a similar manner and some of its files and pamphlets
are contained here as well. Two commission members, William McKinstry
and Dr. E. A. Trabant, kept their own files which can be found here.
Documentation files for individual grants made by the Commission are
included and generally contain the original proposal that specifically
details the workings of the project and a request for funding (theater,
dance, exhibit, etc.). The project was then approved or disapproved,
funding was provided and in the former case, news accounts or programs
of the event were collected. Financial records from the time of
proposal through the final reconciliation of funds are present in most
instances.
One loose volume, a scrapbook, contains newspaper clippings, programs,
tickets, calendars, etc., relating to Commission sponsored events.
