 27X Delaware American Revolution Bicentennial Commission subjects include the Dover Light Infantry, time capsule placed in Willingtown Square, Rodney's ride, Delaware Trust commissioned paintings, Separation Day celebration, the Old State House, and various local celebrations. Constitutional bicentennial photos include the recreation of the ride to the Annapolis Convention, Compass Rose, Delaware Day and Constitution Day in Philadelphia, Constitution Place, bicentennial parade and ceremonies, Delaware stamps and first day covers, and Historical Art of the Bank of Delaware.

Other photographs are of Authors Days, Bill of Rights bicentennial parade and events, illustrations used in various Commission books and publications, Commission directors and members, *Creating Community: Hispanic Migration to Rural Delaware* book signing and photos of Hispanics, Germantown marker dedication, Heritage Camps, Thomas McDonough book and house, Polish Constitution celebration, Caesar Rodney's 1992 ride, Tour DuPont and Tour de Trump, George Alfred Townsend, Mason-Dixon markers, World War I event, and the 1989 George Washington bicentennial.

The three photo albums, 1985-1989, document State House Symposiums, constitutional scholars, Annapolis Convention, Bicentennial Community Improvement projects, Return Day, local bicentennial celebrations, Delaware Day in Philadelphia, "Celebrate the First State" film premier, Constitution Park, Commodore McDonough ceremonies, and the George Washington inaugural bicentennial. Some of the album photos also appear in the photo files.

There is one cd of digital images, 2000-2005. This has photos of Authors Days, Commission staff, an oral history workshop, Milford and Newark historic houses and buildings, Fort Saulsbury, and campers at Greenbank Mill.
