261 Recorded interviews used in the Commission's oral history series of
publications on former Delaware governors and the Hispanic migration to
the state.
270 These records include audio cassettes and some transcripts used in the
books for Governors Elbert Carvel, Sherman Tribbitt, and Russell
Peterson. The Carvel interviews were conducted by Roger Martin, 1996-
1997, for his book, *Elbert N. Carvel*. There are four audio cassettes
with no transcripts.

Christopher Perry interviewed Russell Peterson for his book, *Russell W.
Peterson, Governor of Delaware, 1969-1973*, in 1998-1999. There are
eighteen audio cassettes with transcripts for all except one interview.

For the book, *Sherman W. Tribbitt: Governor of Delaware, 1973-1977*, by
Roger Martin, there are seven interviews with former Governor Tribbitt
as well as interviews with his wife, Jeanne, and others who worked with
him during his political career. They include Francis O. Biondi,
Democratic party leader; Frank Calio, Secretary of Public Safety,
Richard Carter, Administrative Aid; Marge Toop, Personal Secretary,
Richard Cordrey, Senator; Nancy Cook, Senator; Bruce Ennis,
Representative; Clifford B. Hearn, Jr., Representative; Kenneth Madden,
Education; John Poplos, Vice President Farmer's Bank, Ruth Ann Minner,
Legislator; N. C. Vasuki, Department of Natural Resources; John Bryson,
Secretary Department of Natural Resources; Ned Davis, Governor Terry's
Press Secretary and Democratic party leader; and E. Sherman (Skip) Webb,
Jr, Tribbitt's Administrative Assistant and brother-in-law. Typed
transcripts of the audio recordings were done for ten of the twenty
interviews. One of the interviews with Governor Tribbitt exists as a
transcript only.

Katherine Borland's book, *Creating Community: Hispanic Migration to
Rural Delaware*, used interviews with fifty-two participants, 1999-2001.
Many of the interviews were conducted in Spanish. There are fifty-two
audio cassettes. Transcripts are contained on a compact disk. Also
included are interviewee release forms and participant lists which
include their address and affiliation.

These collection also includes oral history interviews relating to the
1968 Wilmington riots, history of Bowers Beach, River and Bay Pilots,
Brown VS The Board of Education and with former Delaware Legislators.
