261 Nathan visited every boundary monument on Delaware's border with Maryland, Pennsylvania, and New Jersey and photographed all 179 markers. This photographic evidence of the condition of each monument aided the boundary commissions during the 1980's and 1990's when the monuments were re-established and new boundary agreements with neighboring states were completed. He was the author of *East of the Mason-Dixon Line, A History of the Delaware Boundaries*.  
270 There are two sets of boundary monument color slides. One set may include views of all four sides of each monument, while the other set may show only two sides. Slides include the state boundary markers as well as markers between the New Castle County and Kent County border and the markers between Kent and Sussex Counties. Slides also include other subjects: New Castle Court House, Brandywine Creek, aerial views, maps, Artificial Island, and Delaware and New Jersey Penn oak trees (trees over three hundred years old). Also present are five boundary related slide presentations compiled by Nathan. Unfortunately, no scripts accompany the presentations.
