261 Records kept by the sheriff of the sales held by county constables in response to court orders.
270 Sale entries generally include the date and location of sale, description of property to be sold or inventory of items sold, name of owner of property (plaintiff), signature of constable, and date of document. Early volume entries also include the name of the plaintiff and defendant, writ number, court term form which the writ originated, to whom property was sold, and often the notation "deed delivered." All volumes reflect sales of both real and personal property. Three of the volumes were kept by sheriffs B. F. Blackiston (1876-1879), C. W. Graham (1921-1922), and J. H. Bullock (1923-1924). Volume for 1899 to 1901 also contains a "boarder book" for what may have been the Delaware House in Harrington. Book was kept by Amos Cole from 1881 through 1884, and is stored with Kent County private accounts.
