 black schools.
 27X The Levy Court assessed on blacks a tax of thirty cents for each hundred
 dollars of real and personal property. Property values were taken from
 the tax assessment lists, and the tax was collected by the tax collector
 of each hundred. The money collected was paid to the county treasurer
 who kept it in a separate fund. The money in the fund was turned over
 to the treasurer of the "Delaware Association for the Education of the
 Colored People" who distributed it to each county for the support and
 maintenance of black schools. (15 D.L., ch. 48.) The delinquent tax
 list shows the name of the tax collector for Milford Hundred (J.D.
 Hill), year of tax (1892), names of delinquent tax payers, amount of
 assessment and tax due for each delinquent, and total amount of tax that
 was delinquent for Milford Hundred.
