27X School district transfer petitions are the requests made by citizens to the Levy Court to have their tax base changed from one district to another. This was usually done for the convenience of students residing in one district but actually living closer to the schoolhouse in an adjacent district. Transfer petitions include name of petitioner, district of residence, number of the preferred district, and reason for petition to transfer. Included with the 1835 petition is a map of districts 19 and 20 which shows the location of the schoolhouse and petitioner's house.
