270 Each volume entry shows the date, town, county, and time of the marriage; groom's name and place of residence; bride's name and place of residence; names of witnesses; and name of person performing the ceremony. Often the name of the minister's church is provided.

The box contains "Record of Marriage License" booklets received from the Justice of the Peace, 1913-1915, 1918-1921. These sheets record the names and residences of the bride and groom, age, color, occupation, marital status, relationship, names of the groom's and bride's parents, date sworn before the Justice of the Peace, and the signature of the Justice and the groom.
