430 It appears from a loose abstract from the 1935 Revised Code (ch. 119,
4473, sec. 28) and a note from a judge after the final entry that those
instruments were to be kept by the Clerk of the Peace. If we can find
where this information was duplicated elsewhere, then these volumes
could be pitched. One volume (1942-1943) was removed from 3805.17. The
other volume (1939-1942) was located in the archives cage. However, no
sheet was ever located, if there ever was one.
