27X Petitions show name of petitioner, hundred and location of road in question, names of adjacent property owners, and date of petition. Court orders show name of petitioner, hundred and location of road, signatures of five appointed commissioners to view the road and date. Commissioners report shows name of petitioner, hundred and location of road, recommended metes and bounds of road, with names of adjacent property owners, dates of report and signatures of commissioners. In later volumes (beginning 1824) surveyor's return is also included which is a plot/sketch of proposed road with metes and bounds, names of property owners, structure locations, name of surveyor, and date of survey.
