27X This series originated in the Court of Common Pleas and was transferred to the newly created Superior Court in 1832. The last volume (1825-1850) includes entries for the Superior Court from 1832-1850. Information contained in the docket entries includes the petition, the court summons and the prisoner's affidavit. Petitions show court term, debtor's name, age, marital status, and dependents, names of plaintiff and other creditors to appear at hearing, date of hearing. date summonses issues, and name of prothonotary. Affidavits show names of debtor, plaintiff or plaintiff's representative, oath of debtor swearing to convey all property to creditors, date of affidavit and discharge and signatures of debtor and Prothonotary.
