27X Orders to divide include names of surveyors, number of districts to be surveyed, number of new district, minimum number of white students allowed per district, and description of how the surveyors are to set forth metes and bounds. Also included with many orders are the reports of the surveyors. Reports include the opinion re: division, and precise descriptions of the new district's mete and bounds. These reports also include date of report to the Clerk of the Peace, signatures of the surveyors, and number of days worked.
