 27X Jurors are classified as grand jurors, general jurors, jurors for the Court of Oyer and Terminer, and jurors for the Supreme Court. Under these categories, the name of the proposed juror is given. If he did not serve, the name of his replacement is shown. Also shown is the number of days served, the amount to be paid to each juror, and if an order on the county treasurer was delivered. The first few pages and the last pages (1795-1797, 1811-1813) list the hundred of residence. Often the bailiffs are also listed with the amounts owed them. Beginning in 1800, the number of miles each juror traveled is provided. Occupations for each juror is noted for October Term 1811 through 1813.
