261 Record of guardians appointed by the Court to manage and oversee the affairs and financial accounts of children of minor age.
270 Record shows names of minor and guardian, guardian's surety amount; date guardian was appointed; address or hundred of residence; dates accounts presented for approval by the court; and total amount of capital and income for each account. Entries from 1852 to about 1857 do not show date of appointment. Entries from mid-1882 to the end of that volume, 1901, cease to record any information regarding passed guardian accounts. Entries for volume 1909-1947, begin more consistently around 1920. Earlier year recordings are sporadic.
