261 Scrapbooks, two audio tapes, and a motion picture relating to the Dover and Lamia, Greece sister city agreement. The sister city designation was a product of the People to People program established by President Dwight Eisenhower to foster understanding and peace between the citizens of various nations.

270 The scrapbooks include newspaper clippings, photographs, correspondence, and publications detailing relations between the two cities, especially a trip to Lamia by Dover officials and citizens in 1963. The first scrapbook won an award in the People to People Town Affiliation competition in 1964. Also included are copies of articles in the *Delaware State News* covering the trip to Greece, copies of a speech by Senator Caleb Boggs printed in the *Congressional Register* praising the sister city program, photos and program for the dedication of Lamia Place, correspondence and photos relating to Greek exchange students at Wesley College, information about a local student organization, and information about trips by Dover residents to Greece.

One audio tape was recorded by Dover radio station WDOV for its "Distaff Delaware" broadcast on March 25, 1964. Sug Adlam, Mayor Crawford Carroll, and Fred Brittan were interviewed about the People to People program. The other audio tape features Lady Bird Johnson and Dean Rusk speaking about the People to People sister city organization at the National Town Affiliations Conference, nd. The motion picture documents the "Lamia Place" dedication ceremonies that were held as part of Dover's 250<sup>th</sup> anniversary celebration, May 12, 1967.
