Department, with annual City financial reports included in the back of the  
booklets.  
270 The reports are for the Waterworks, 1883-1899, Light and Waterworks,  
1900-1917, and a City financial statement for 1933-1934. The first  
annual report for the Waterworks has a history of firefighting and the  
water system in Dover. It notes the size of mains for various streets,  
location of stopgates and fire hydrants, and the cost of construction.  
Most of the annual reports have a report from the Water Committee (later  
the Light and Waterworks Committee), superintendent, and chief engineer  
which may note the water rates, statements of receipts and expenditure,  
and a list of tools and materials. Later reports may include a report  
from the Fire Department and the Tree Committee. The 1912 report  
includes a record of fires in the City from 1902 to 1912 and shows the  
amount of fire loss for 1885-1912. Some reports also list the names of  
City Council members, committee members, and other town officials. The  
City Financial Statements start in 1888 and show the receipts and  
expenditures for various funds and may show the amount of assets and  
liabilities.
