Records include financial records, assessment lists, deed, charter data, collectors accounts, survey, bylaws, petitions, correspondence, official notices, condemnations, reports, elections and resignations, treasurer's bonds, and voters lists.

The assessment lists show names of taxables, year of tax, structures on property, assessment rate, and amount of tax. The deed is between Joseph R. Hall and wife of Mississippi, Hettie R. Hall and others of the town of Lewes to lands in Lewes and Rehoboth Hundred. Collectors accounts of taxes show fiscal year, name of taxable, amount due and total amount to be collected. The survey return is of a survey to ascertain the limits and boundaries of the town of Lewes which shows names of property owners, the name of the surveyor and date of the return; the survey also shows location and names of streets in Lewes. Petitions show names of petitioners and matters under consideration such as purchases of lots of land, complaints, construction of ditches and the opening of new roads and date of petition; reports of committees appointed concerning matters before the town commissioners. Elections and resignations file contain certificates of elected officials and resignation letters of the same; voters lists give year of election, elected positions open and lists of voters eligible for election. [See also election results.] The financial records contain records of disbursements, receipts, and vouchers. Also includes broadside of town meeting.
NB: Only one document predates 1818 incorporation. It is a receipt for money from a judgment against someone in Lewes.
