 27X One program is for Project Adventure, a program designed to offer students an opportunity to meet the real world, take risks, and engage in practical problem solving. Project Adventure has a physical education component using initiative games and ropes courses; and an academic curriculum component. The slides illustrate these activities. The second slide show deals with the Comprehensive Achievement Monitoring (CAM) program, a computer assisted program for monitoring students' progress. Slides were provided by the PACE Demonstration Evaluation Center in Minnesota. Further slides document teachers and students at work in the early 1940's, other views of school life as well as slides of miscellaneous historic sites. Some filmstrips and audio tapes are present here as well.
