 270 The reports are for New Castle County, 1924; Eastern New Castle County, 1926-1933; and Western New Castle County, 1933-1955. The monthly reports are similar in nature and are for New Castle County, 1953-1955.

The reports usually have a statistical section which may note the number of one teacher schools, two teacher schools, three or more teacher schools, total number of schools and teachers, and number of white and "colored" schools and teachers. Also noted is the number of days spent visiting schools, doing office work, absent from work, and attending professional meetings; number of visits made; number of rooms in unsatisfactory or worse, satisfactory or better, and conditions were favorable or unfavorable; number of teachers given suggestions at time of visit, circular letters sent to teachers, and teachers given suggestions by individual letter; number of local meetings held and teachers attending; number of lessons taught and observed; and number of conferences held with individual teachers.

Other subjects discussed include teacher meetings, health education, student savings accounts, professional reading, yearly objectives, school clubs, reading, libraries, handwriting, geography, social studies, intervisitation, oral expression, home visitation, child development, conferences, war savings stamps and bonds, other war efforts, parent-teacher associations, testing program, overcrowded schools, drinking water supply, and special needs students.
