270 "A Brief Statement of the Transition from the Old Colored Schools of Dover to the New Colored Schools," describes the 1922 events and ceremonies on the day of the move from schools on Slaughter Street and Division Street to the new du Pont school, Booker T. Washington. It notes the number of students from each school, the grades in each, and names of teachers.

The 1914 "Report of the Proceedings of Annual Stated Meeting of School Voters" for school districts 18, 60, 90, 91, 92, and 101 provides varied information about the schools in Dover. It notes the officers appointed or elected, school expenditures and receipts, information about the teachers, and school statistics. For the teachers, it shows their names, days taught, salary per month, and the number of male and female students. It also reports on the number of days the school was open, value of school books, value of the school grounds, buildings, and furniture, total assets amount, district indebtedness, amount of insurance on the schoolhouse, and the date of the report.
