Other subjects include a 1956 Louis Armstrong concert, Joseph Biden, Thomas Carper, Barnum and Bailey circus, 1952 Dwight Eisenhower rally, New Castle airbase, New Castle-Pennsville ferry, Our Lady of Peace sculpture, William Roth, Senate, Charles and Jessica Terry, Sherman Tribbitt, and Wilmington scenes. Most photos are black and white, although there are some color prints and transparencies.

Color slide subjects (1965-1996) include Port Mahon Lighthouse, Dover Days, Tour DuPont, St. Anthony's festival, Spence's Bazaar, state representatives, ETV, Dover buildings and scenes, Silver Lake Park, Special Olympics, nature/outdoors scenes, Delaware State University track and field events, Dover Air Force Base, Dover arts festival, Woodburn, New Castle, Lewes, Cape Henlopen, Wilmington, Dover parades, and Clyde Beatty Cole Circus.
