261 Many of the photographs were taken by Clarence D. Sypherd (1864-1926), a Dover pharmacist, state representative, and First Lieutenant/Paymaster in the First Delaware Regiment during the Spanish-American War. The son of Rev. Jacob Owen and Josephine Draper Sypherd, he graduated from the Philadelphia College of Pharmacy and became a licensed Dover pharmacist in 1887. He joined his future father-in-law, David Foster Burton, at Burton's drugstore on the corner of Loockerman and State Streets. Clarence married Maria (Minnie) E. Burton on May 20, 1891, and their son, Clarence B. was born in 1895. He was elected as a state representative in 1894, was president of the Delaware Pharmaceutical Society in 1896, and by 1908 was secretary and treasurer of the Farmers & Merchants' National Building and Loan Association.

270 This collection of photographs reflects Sypherd's personal and family interests. Subjects include family and friends, family property, honeymoon and vacation photos, and views of Dover, the St. Jones River, Kitts Hummock, and Rehoboth. Some of the same images are in the print box and in the album. Some of the prints in the album are cyanotypes. Most of the smaller glass negatives are not identified and it is not clear whether they were taken by Sypherd.
