 270 This collection contains family genealogy research of the Bennett, Candy, Davis, Fiddeman, Fleming, Harrington, Hazzard, Richardson, Robinson, Satterfield, Stites, Tilney, Tomlinson, and Walker families. Included in the files are pedigrees, copies of Bible records, correspondence between family members, and newspaper clippings. Notable records include a Mr. and Mrs. Thomas Davis 50th wedding anniversary pamphlet, The Fleming family reunion pamphlet, Charles H. Fleming's School for Little Boys report card, and a copy of Charles H. Fleming's Pennsylvania birth certificate. Also in the collection are silhouettes of Peter Stites, Hannah Wills Stites, and Prudence Stites, letters settling estates, obituaries for Henry L. Walker and William H. Walker, an application for the Pennsylvania Society of the Colonial Dames, and a memoriam booklet for Alden Bradford Richardson.

 The collection also includes a folder on Dover. Included in this folder is a booklet titled *Recollections of Dover in 1824* by Judge George Purnell Fisher, *Stories from Dover's Court House Records* by George Valentine Massey II, and Mrs. A. E. Watson's "Story of Dover Green" as told by the Kent County Club Members. Also included is a flyer titled "Columbus Day 10/21/1892 - Dover Public Schools," "Historic Dover: A Look into the Historic Background of the State Capital," a one page paper discussing the burial vault at Cooper's Corner, and newspaper clippings.
