(father), and Willard P. Hatfield (son) for their inter-personal,
farming, and private accounts. The farm was located on the Milford
Road, east of Greenwood.
270 The volume shows an account heading, date, transaction, and amount.
There are a number entries for the sale of broiler chickens, growing and
harvesting truck crops, farm expenses, and car expenses. Several
entries note they sold chickens and produce to Delaware State College,
Beebe Hospital, the Civilian Conservation Corps, and H. P. Cannon &
Sons, a Bridgeville cannery.

The book was first used by Mary E. Holland, Mission Study Department,
Dover District Epworth League, 1906-1908, to record efforts in each area
Methodist church. For each church it lists the number of classes held,
and may show the name of the text book used, name of the leader, and
names of participants most interested. Most of the book was used for
the Hatfield accounts.
