as well as payroll. Other records include monthly estimates of work  
done, monthly return of force, deeds for right of ways, articles of  
agreements, property plots, and advertisements. Oversize records  
include an advertisement for "The Trenton Iron Works Sections of Rolled  
Iron"; an agreement between the Wilmington and Northern Railroad and the  
Delaware Railroad, 1899; estimates on the line from Seaford to Dover;  
broadsides for Board of Director's meetings, 1847, 1852; and freight  
returns, 1862.
